

Lesson Plan: Transformers

Theme: God has healing, life-giving, transforming power. He uses us as his hands, feet, mouths,...we are transformers!

Scripture:

1. The Transfiguration – Jesus is transformed up on the mountain, and the disciples who are with him are witnesses to help them believe. As Jesus comes down the mountain, a father asks him to heal his son. The disciples who were not on the mountain did not have enough faith to heal the boy. The father believed and the boy was healed. Who brought the boy to Jesus?
2. The Raising of Lazarus – Lazarus is dead. Jesus believes God can bring him back to life. When Jesus calls Lazarus out of the tomb what happens? He walks out as a cadaver, and Jesus tells the people to unwind the cloth and set him free. Who moved the stone? Who unwound the cloth?
3. The Raising of Jesus – Jesus dies and is buried. When his friends go to the tomb, they discover it is empty. What do they believe and why?

God has power. God can heal the sick and bring the dead back to life.

What did Jesus say is needed from us?

Bring others to Jesus, especially those who need healing

Believe that healing can happen

Move the stones

Unwind the bandages

Believe that God can work miracles and give life
